

## Chapter 9.42

### DISTURBING THE PEACE\*

**9.42.010**      **Generally.** No person shall within the limits of the city commit any of the offenses set out in Sections 9.42.020 through 9.42.090. (Ord. 74-399 s. 1(part), 1974; prior code s. 18.02(part)).

**9.42.020**      **Loud or raucous noise unlawful.** No person shall make any unnecessary and annoying noise. No person shall, through the means of sound amplifiers or other instruments, make or emit loud or raucous noises in the public streets, public parks or other public places. (Ord. 74-399 s. 1(part), 1974; prior code s. 18.02(part)).

**9.42.025**      **Helicopter and Aircraft Use for Construction Purposes Prohibited from 8:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m.** No person may use or permit the use of any helicopter or other aircraft for construction or construction related purposes anywhere in the City between the hours of 8:00 o'clock p.m. and 8:00 o'clock a.m. each night, except for emergencies.

**9.42.030**      **Assault unlawful.** No person shall assault another when not excusable or justifiable, or use in reference to and in the presence of another, or in reference to and in the presence of any member of his family, abusive or obscene language intended or naturally tending to provoke an assault or any breach of the peace. (Ord. 74-399 s. 1(part), 1974; prior code s. 18.02(part)).

**9.42.040**      **Prowling unlawful.** No person shall prowl about the premises of another in the nighttime, or peek in windows on another's premises, or do any other act intended or naturally tending to frighten or alarm other persons. (Ord. 74-399 s. 1(part), 1974; prior code s. 18.02(part)).
